(John 17.1–11)

Easter 7 - Year A - Jesus prays for His disciples. (based on John 17: 1-11)

Jesus knew it would not always be easy to be a Christian. He understood that doing the right thing, loving God and our neighbour, helping those in need, caring for the sick, praying faithfully, worshipping regularly and being honest is not the way of everyone else in the world, but it is God's way of living. So, as he prepares to return to God the creator of all things, his father in heaven, he prays for this disciples, and therefore all Christians that we may be faithful and united in love. To help us follow God's way, Jesus promises the Holy Spirit will be poured out upon the Church, to lead us into all truth and to guide us in holiness.

Jesus prays, "All mine are yours, and yours are mine; and I have been glorified in them. And now I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one." (verses 10 & 11)

The Ascension of Jesus

40 days after Easter day and His resurrection, Jesus Ascended into heaven.

Jesus said to the disciples, 'These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you – that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled.' Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them, 'Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And see, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.' Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy; and they were continually in the temple blessing God. (Luke 24: 44-53)

Jesus left the disciples on earth to continue His message of love, faith, hope and the reconciliation of all back to God, that we may be drawn closer to God in heaven and live faithful lives here on earth. That is why Jesus prayed to God, "I glorified you on earth by finishing the work that you gave me to do. So now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had in your presence before the world existed."

(John 17: 4, 5)

We are the disciples today with that same message for everyone - God loves you!

Prayer

Lord Jesus, you are the way to the Father and reign in the glory of heaven! You were sent to love us to freedom and we thank you that you love us for ever. **Amen.**






