


Jesus – Life & Ministry

Art can help us reflect upon Jesus and his ministry.



A busy ministry over a short period

- He was only about 30 years old when he began preaching which lasted 3 years until he was crucified.
- During his ministry he taught about God and the values of God's kingdom, prayed, healed, loved, forgave and renewed relationships.
- He also challenged those who had their priorities wrong and was not afraid to stand up for justice, honesty and truth.



Who then is Jesus?



Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, 'Who do people say that the Son of Man is?' And they said, 'Some say John the Baptist, but others Elijah, and still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.' He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?' Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.'

Jesus is a window onto God

Jesus is a teacher

The New Testament as a whole (especially the Gospels) help us to know about Jesus' life and the work he was about.

Through them He teaches us about:

- The Good News
- God's kingdom
- God's justice & mercy
- Forgiveness
- A right way of living
- Community & fellowship
- Discipleship
- How to pray
- Holy Communion (Bread & Wine)



How can we understand Jesus... well, he is...

- He is fully human and yet fully God (Divine)
- God among us, Emmanuel.
- He brings a message of the Kingdom repent and be faithful to God.
- He brings healing & is a miracle worker the miracles demonstrate his power and yet they point to a change within the lives of those who encounter Jesus.
- Jesus shows us something wonderful about God – He breaks down the old barrier of sin that we may draw closer to God who loves us and calls us home to him.





The Jesus Prayer

The Jesus Prayer (also known as The Prayer) is a short formulaic prayer used by Christians world-wide, open repeated many times (especially within the Eastern churches).

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.
