

Parochial Fees Policy & Charges 2019

At St Mary's Church, Thorpe we apply the Church of England Fees as set (see www.churchofengland.org) and where the minister has to travel, an additional £30 travel fee is applicable. Between 1st October and 31st April, the PCC applies a £50 additional heating charge for use of the Church. All fees and lettings are to be made payable to **St Mary's Church Thorpe**.

The Incumbent assigns all their fees to the Diocese of Guilford. The Parish Treasurer pays the Diocesan Fees quarterly to Guildford Diocesan Board of Finance.

(excluding Advent & Lent)£45Choir or cantor to support music/singing£60

Minister, organist, verger & set fees £345

Additional charges:

If burial at Thorpe Cemetery follows £28

If burial elsewhere or committal at a crematorium follows £58 (includes travel)

Funerals at a Crematorium / Graveside

Service at a Crematorium £225 (includes travel)

Service at the Graveside Thorpe Cemetery £69 Other location £99

Burial of cremated remains (ashes) in St Mary's Churchyard

Burial of ashes including sexton £19

For those who have lived in historic Thorpe Parish, have been members of the Church Electoral Roll or had a clear connection to the parish through a family member or school. (The burial of caskets or containers or the marking of the location is strictly prohibited)

Extra Church Heating

For all weddings, funerals, concerts and other church building use between 1st October and 31st

For use of the Rutherwyke Room per hour# £16

^{*} No church fee is changed for the funeral of a person under the age of 16 years.

[#] A discounted rate is available to charities in negotiation with the Churchwarden. Lettings of the Church must be agreed with the wardens and Vicar on an individual basis and will be subject to an additional charge for heating as above. All hirers must sign a booking form and adhere to the Church of England safeguarding policy.
