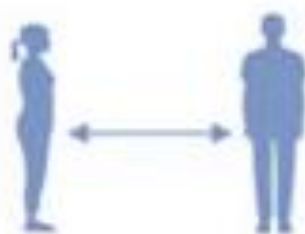




Understanding Social Distancing

On entering the Rutherwyke Room please

- AFFIX A FACE MASK *
- WASH YOUR HANDS FOR 20 SECONDS (usually in the Kitchen)
- SIGN IN (test & trace purposes) **

Follow the one-way system around our buildings and all advice from wardens on duty.

*The toilets may be used, but only by one individual or household at a time. Before entry, please slide the **occupied/vacant** sign to identify you are inside the toilet.*

Inside St Mary's Church please keep **2m** (6ft) or 3 chairs *in all directions* apart from other individuals or households.
Affix a small sticky note to the chair where you sit to identify cleaning later.

Communal Worship & Funerals are restricted to **30** max in Church.
(and up to 8 staff for all services)
*Weddings, Baptisms, and other life events are not currently possible****

The Rutherwyke Room is not available for hire currently due to Lockdown restrictions.

For all other activities:
agreed staff or 1 household only
*otherwise, the buildings are **closed**.*
