


# Understanding Social Distancing

## Covid-secure protocols at St Mary's Church



Keep at least  
**2 metres** apart.

If feeling unwell in  
any way, please  
**STAY AT HOME** and  
watch worship online.



Outside service times  
only **2** households can  
mix indoors.

On entering the Rutherwyke Room please

- AFFIX A FACE MASK \*
- WASH YOUR HANDS FOR 20 SECONDS (usually in the Kitchen)
- SIGN IN (test & trace purposes) \*\*

*Please follow the one-way system around the church and inside our buildings along with all advice from our wardens.*

*The toilets may be used, but only by one individual or household at a time. Before entry, please slide the **occupied**/**vacant** sign to identify you are inside the toilet.*

Inside St Mary's Church the chairs are set out in pairs **2m** (6ft) apart from other seats to separate individuals or households. Affix a small sticky note to the chair where you sit to identify for cleaning later.

Following covid-secure protocols, Thorpe PCC have completed a full risk-assessment of our buildings and grounds. Numbers permitted inside are restricted until 21 June\*\*\*.

Communal Worship and Funeral:

**40** in Church.

Weddings, Baptisms & Burials of Ashes:

**30** in Church.

(in addition, up to 8 staff for all services)

The Rutherwyke Room is available for hire, but numbers are restricted to **10** max.
